- The highlights of the Damage Reporting Tool are:
 - Can be used by all excavators
 - Does not meet MPSC damage reporting requirements for Facility Owner/Operators currently, we are working with the MPSC to streamline the process
 - Will be sent anonymously to Michigan Virtual Private DIRT which is part of the CGA DIRT Collection Report

- There was one question asked after the video was shown:
 - **Which facility owner do I contact if I hit a line? The facility owner that I work for or the facility owner of the line that I hit?** *You should always contact the owner of the line that was hit.*
