**DISCUSSION:** A very small group due to many being off already for the holidays. We are hoping to set a date for the Spring Kickoff at or before the next meeting. Shannon from USIC said that he is finding that within a city or village, it's better for road work tickets to be called in on a block-by-block basis; while in rural areas the one mile/2 mile works fine. He also noted that he's noticing that there is a higher probability of areas being missed when dealing with non-consecutive multiple address tickets as opposed to consecutive address tickets. Another issue that's common in winter is unmarked facilities tickets being called in after snow storms instead of destroyed markings. It was noted that a township in the area may own electrical but it isn't being marked. Also brought up was that the state law pertains only to power tools, but CFR 196 Title 49 in the code of federal regulations references excavation including non-mechanized tools as well.
