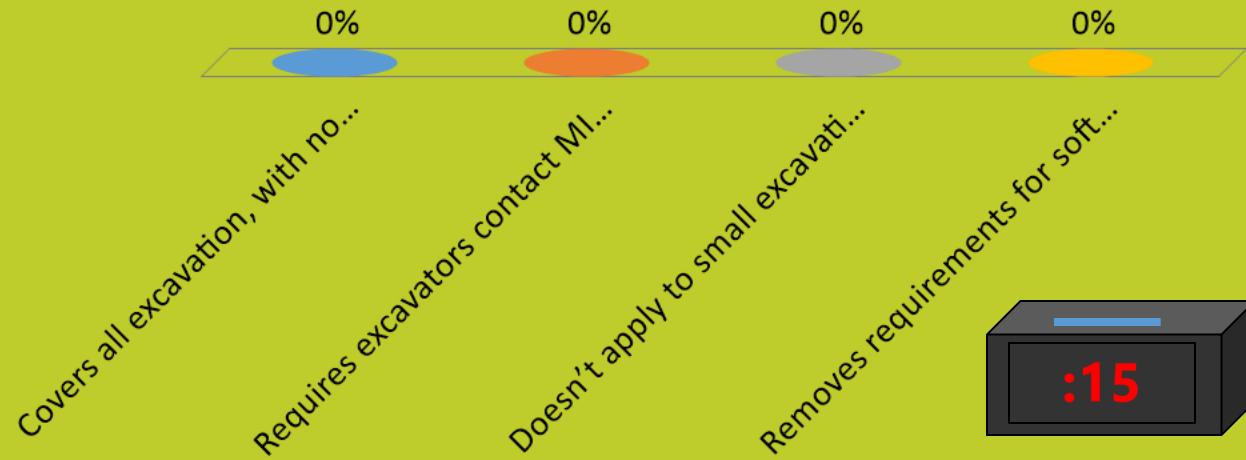


MISS DIG 811



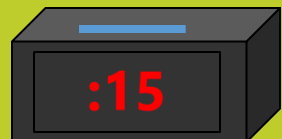
Public Act 174:

- A. Covers all excavation, with no exceptions
- ✓ B. Requires excavators contact MISS DIG 811 at LEAST 3 business days but not more than 14 calendar days before work begins
- C. Doesn't apply to small excavating companies with fewer than 10 employees
- D. Removes requirements for soft excavation to expose pipelines



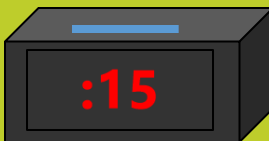
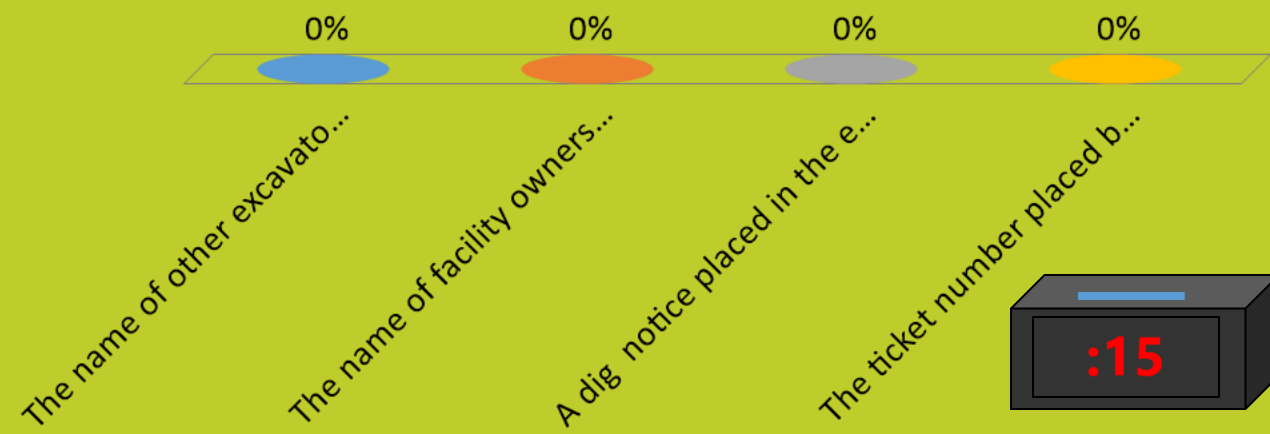
