

Temporary Emergency Medical Site Work Type Best Practice

In response to the requirement that essential businesses screen employees prior to entrance to work sites, some companies are installing temporary emergency medical sites or overflow areas. These may be work types are not commonly seen as an emergency ticket (e.g. Tent Install). Therefore, MISS DIG 811 has asked the following verbiage be placed in the Work Type field: “temporary emergency medical site.” It is our hope that the common work type will make these tickets easy to identify so our members can respond in a timely manner.

RTE users: In the Work Type field enter, “Temporary emergency medical site.”

Calling 811: Let the NSR know that the Work Type field should read “Temporary emergency medical site.”
