Meeting Minutes:

Return to Work – Bruce read the memo that is going out. Rob suggested adding project ticket for those who could maintain marks, Bruce added that members suggest that they have higher damage rates with project tickets. Rob asked about locators' staffing needs and whether they have enough employees. Brian said that they are demand driven and have daily calls. They can have everyone available within 24 hours. Rob has a video to share with Bruce that talks about



working on construction sites during the virus. MISS DIG plans on getting this info out as soon as we can, education is working on a tutorial for returning to work.

Brian and Andy said that stay at home may go into next month as well. Vince voiced his concern about staking too early where remarks may be needed.
